Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Glen & Rita Chapman/Democratic Republic of the Congo (Evangelism/Discipleship/Theological Education/Education/Economic Development) ~ Glen and Rita have been instrumental in moving the Kikongo pastoral training school up to university level. The new university has three majors: theology, agriculture, and teacher training. Glen is the academic dean of the school of theology and teaches Old Testament, Hebrew, and Baptist distinctives. Rita is in charge of the library, teaches English, and works with the wives of the theology students. Glen has been involved in experimenting with a Powered Parachute for transporting fragile audiovisual equipment to villages. With this equipment, they can project evangelistic films as well as videos about conservation, health, sports, music, and other educational topics.

SBC Missionaries: Rob & Riley Russell (Lead Church Planter) Restoration Church, Manhattan, NY ~ Restoration Church is a new church in the West Village of lower Manhattan. As a growing church community, they exist for the purpose of cultivating gospel restoration, allowing the gospel to transform the way we think, feel, and act in life and in community for the glory of God and the good of others. Over the past several months, they have begun pursuing this mission by launching multiple community groups, offering a weekend Bible study and finding ways to tangibly serve in their community, an area, which according to their neighbors, hasn't seen an active church in 50 years.
