Missionary Emphasis:
ABC International Ministries: Lea Lindero/Thailand ~ Lea is an associate missionary who works as a nurse in the Center for the Development of People with Disabilities (CDPD) in Thailand. She works in the center itself and in rural villages as part of the center's mobile health clinic. She helps give health education, teaches basic English to the staff and offers other assistance as needed. In addition to her responsibilities at the CDPD, Lea is part of the Community-Based Rehabilitation Program, through which she reaches out to ethnic minority groups in mountain villages and to the local Thai Population.

SBC Missionaries: Eli & Helen Choi /Serving as Lead Church Planters, Home Church, Frederick, Maryland ~ Home Church is a new church being planted in the Urbana area of Frederick, Md. Their vision is to make Jesus known by making disciples and planting churches. God opened doors for Home Church to launch out of The Ranch, a drug and alcohol addiction treatment center in Frederick. They believe the Holy Spirit will save, redeem and heal those who are separated from God and will bring many homes into a relationship with Him. Currently, 90 percent of Frederick County is not connected to a gospel-preaching church. They believe God has called Home Church to be part of changing that number.
