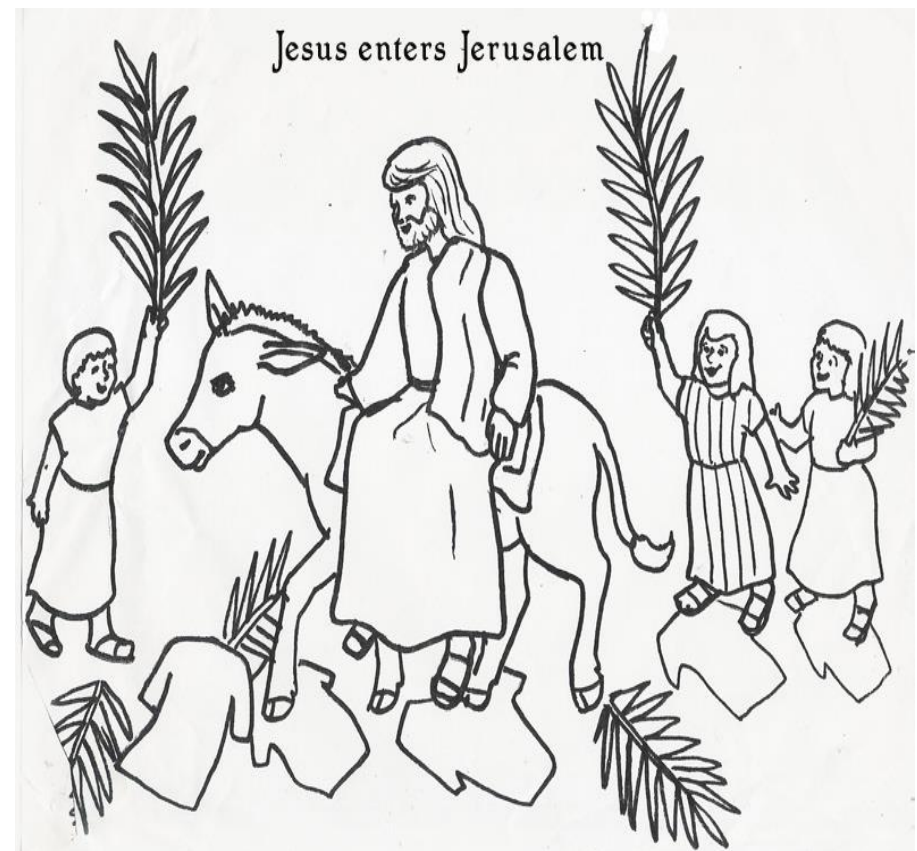

**Missionary Emphasis:**

**ABC International Ministries: Kyle & Katrina Williams/ Evangelism; Theological Education/ Democratic Republic of the Congo** ~ Kyle and Katrina Williams from Everett, Washington, have been commissioned to serve in partnership with the Baptist Community of Congo at the Baptist University of Congo. They will assist with the training of students in theology, psychology, literacy and church and rural development. Kyle has recently finished a Master's of Science at Central Washington University where he focused on racism and tribalism, its driving mechanism and techniques to overcome it. Katrina is a photographer and graphic artist. Together they have worked summers at a family commercial fishing site in Alaska and are homeschooling their four children.

**SBC Missionaries: Ben & Rachel Heile, Hope Church, Salt Lake City, Utah** ~ God planted Hope Church in the fall of 2014 in one of the pastor's homes. Since that time, they have outgrown two locations and are currently meeting at a co-working facility in the town of Sandy, just south of Salt Lake City. Hope Church is a welcoming place for people to encounter the gospel and interact with a genuine Christian community. God is making their church a light in a city with almost no evangelical presence. They are amazed at how God is working in Salt Lake City every week!

**SBC Chaplaincy: Bitrus Cobong**, who was born and born again in northern Nigeria, has been an **Air Force Reserve Chaplain** since 2009. He was called to Active Duty in the Air Force (AF) in 2014 and has been working as a Chaplain in **Colorado Springs** since then. His family's experience in the Chaplain Corps has opened their eyes to the mission field right in their yard. He is currently in the process of applying to go as a full-time Chaplain in the AF. If the door opens, they will be transitioning by next summer.
