Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Lori & Matt Mann/Laos ~ In Laos, Lori and Matt work with street children, slum children, and girls who have been sold or are at high risk of being sold to human traffickers. In order to help protect and restore these children, the Manns are involved in five main interventions: a day time drop-in center for street and slum children; residential care for boys who were brought off the street and for girls who were victims of human trafficking or are at high risk of being victims; a scholarship program for children who would otherwise be sent to the city to beg; and raising community awareness about issues such as child abuse, child exploitation, and human trafficking. To protect their work in Laos, the Manns do not post journals or photos on the internet.

SBC Missionaries: Jim Stansberry (Church - Porter Mountain Fellowship, Lakeside, AZ, SBC) ~ Jim serves as a public safety chaplain for the Pinetop/Lakeside Police Department, the Navajo County sheriff's office, the White River Police Department, and the Pinetop Fire Department.
