Much of the mission work that Madeline organizes takes place in the severely impoverished bateyes (bah-tays) communities. Teams meet local needs by bringing supplies such as food, clothes and bedding; setting up medical clinics; or offering training in hygiene, birth control or domestic violence prevention.

**SBC Missionaries: Sunil Prasad (Lead Church Planter, Relationship Indian Community Church, Cincinnati, OH)** ~ God called him to serve the Lord by planting a church in Mason, OH, which has over 8,000 Indians.
