Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Steve & Nancy James/Haiti ~ After 14 years of medical mission work at the Good Samaritan Hospital, Steve as a doctor and Nancy as a nurse, the Haitian Baptist Convention invited the Jameses to return to Haiti to help with medical assistance to Christian faith based community health centers. Working as medical consultants, the Jameses serve as members of local Christian health teams providing physical, mental, and spiritual health in Jesus' name to those suffering in darkness.

SBC Missionaries: Dennis King (Institutional Chaplaincy, Fairhope Avenue Baptist Church, Fairhope, Alabama) ~ Dennis King taught in prisons since 2013, and then became a NAMB prison chaplain in 2016. As a 20-yr. veteran in the U.S.M.C. and U.S. Army, he spent half his career as an enlisted soldier and the other half as an officer. He ministers at the Disciple of Jesus Halfway House for ex-inmates, men and women, and indigent veterans program provides long-term (6 months to 1 yr.) -transitional shelter, supervision, and employment assistance. To help them return as productive members of society, he helps develop their social skills and instill a sense of responsibility by offering training and education of secular and religious content.

SBC Chaplaincy: Lieutenant Willaim "Edmund" Newsome, CHC, Chaplain, U.S. Navy, Based: Naval District Washington, D.C., Arlington National Cemetery ~ Pray for the service members and their families who are going through the grieving process at Arlington National Cemetery.
