Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Kit Ripley/Abolishing Global, Health & Wellness/Thailand ~ Kit's primary ministry is with Imago Art Studio, an outreach of the New Life Center Foundation in northern Thailand. She provides direct clinical care for survivors of trauma including sexual abuse, human trafficking, and domestic violence through therapeutic art groups and life-skills workshops. She also promotes spiritual formation through preaching. Bible teaching, and facilitating art and contemplative prayer retreats. Additionally, Kit provides support and consultation for the New Life Center administrative team and board of directors, does staff development and training and assists with guest relations and promotional materials.

SBC Missionaries: William Haas (Lead Church Planter, Bemidji, Lac du Flambeau Bible Baptist Church, Bemidji, Minnesota) ~ William is an enrolled member of the Citizen Potawatomi tribe, which has its headquarters in Oklahoma. They are planting churches and serving the Lord in northern Wisconsin and the upper Peninsula of Michigan. Primarily their work is among the Ojibwe and Potawatomi people. They are currently serving the Lord on the Lac du Flambeau Reservation in northern Wisconsin and have been assisting a small church in Sault Sainte Marie, Michigan.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: DAVID DAUS ~ As a hospice chaplain with Ogeechee Area Hospice, he provides care for patients in their in-patient and residential facility, along with homecare patients in Tattall County, where he lives and pastors. He also pastors Rogers Church. His connection with NAMB is as an Air Force Reserve Chaplain, where he served for 16 years. He is currently the Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA) to the Deputy Command Chaplain for USAF/AFAFRICA at Ramstein Air Base in Germany.
