Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Debbie Mulneix/South & East Asia

~ Debbie serves as a regional consultant, promoting volunteer and short-term mission opportunities in Asia for U.S. churches and individuals. She provides training for the volunteers before their arrival in Asia. The training is designed to prepare their hearts and souls for cross-cultural ministry and to help enrich their volunteer experience. Debbie assists volunteers, teams and partner churches in developing their work plans together, using their combined skills and resources to respond to the needs God has set before them.

SBC Missionaries: Phuoc Phan (Philip) Tran (Lead Church Planter, Vietnamese Baptist Linh-an Church, Vancouver, British Columbia ~ Philip planted the church five years ago. Last year, he started a Bible study group in Victoria, with the intention of it becoming a church in the near future. Once a month, he goes there to help that Vietnamese group get to know God better. He also goes to a correctional center in Fraser Valley, British Columbia, to preach to inmates about God. In the past eight years, more than 500 people (of all different nationalities) have become believers.

SBC Chaplaincy: James Brown (Army Chaplain, Fort Hood, TX) ~ Chaplain Brown's ministry started while attending Gateway Seminary Arizona campus. He worked with Set Free Baptist Fellowship in the inner-city of Phoenix, ministering to men who made destructive choices in life. God used that time to open doors as a chaplain. Starting off in Arizona as a prison chaplain, he ministered to inmates in maximum security and death row. He currently serves as an Army Chaplain. Through moves, temporary duty assignments and deployments, God continues to open doors to share Jesus and His redemption in the most amazing places and ways.
