**BACKPACKS FOR THE HOMELESS IN WASHINGTON AND WAYNESBURG**  
We will be collecting the following items for our annual "Homeless Backpack Project": New Testaments; Hats; Gloves; Scarfs; Socks (2 pairs); Water Bottles; Small note pad with pencil; and Toiletries (hotel lotion, shampoo, soap, etc.) We need 45 of each item, except for socks (90 needed). The City Mission will get 20 backpacks (5 for women & 15 for men) and 25 (10 for women & 15 for men) will go to Waynesburg. **Missionary Emphasis:**  
**ABC International Ministries: Karen Smith/Thailand** ~ Karen is the program consultant to the New Life Center Foundation (NLCF), which serves ethnic minority women who are at risk for labor exploitation. The NLCF also provides protection and rehabilitation services to young woman who are survivors of human trafficking, forced labor, and sexual abuse. NCLF activities for elementary to university are educational scholarship support, vocational training, and therapeutic services for survivors, including art, dance, music therapy, and counseling. They are warmly evangelical as they strive to demonstrate the love of Jesus to all residents.

**SBC Missionaries: Luke & Dominee Callender (Church Planting Team Member, Grace Harbor Church, New Bedford, Massachusetts)** ~ New England is the "new American missional frontier." New Bedford, Mass., is a city of about 130,000 people (with the surrounding area comprised of another 120,000 people) situated about an hour south of Boston and 45 minutes east of Providence, R.I.  
Establishing a church there will be a work of perseverance and steadfastness, because New Bedford has the unique challenges of being in a post-Christian culture and an urban context.

**SBC CHAPLAINCY: Tom & Kelley Allen (Catalyst Church, Newport News, VA/ Lieutenant Colonel Tom Allen, Washington, D.C.)** ~ The Allens love serving soldiers and their families in the United States Army and appreciate your prayers and support as they seek to live and show Christ to them. This has been a very demanding but also very rewarding ministry for the Allens. . They have endured deployments to Iraq, Afghanistan, and Hawaii, but God has shown His faithfulness to them throughout their lives and ministry.
