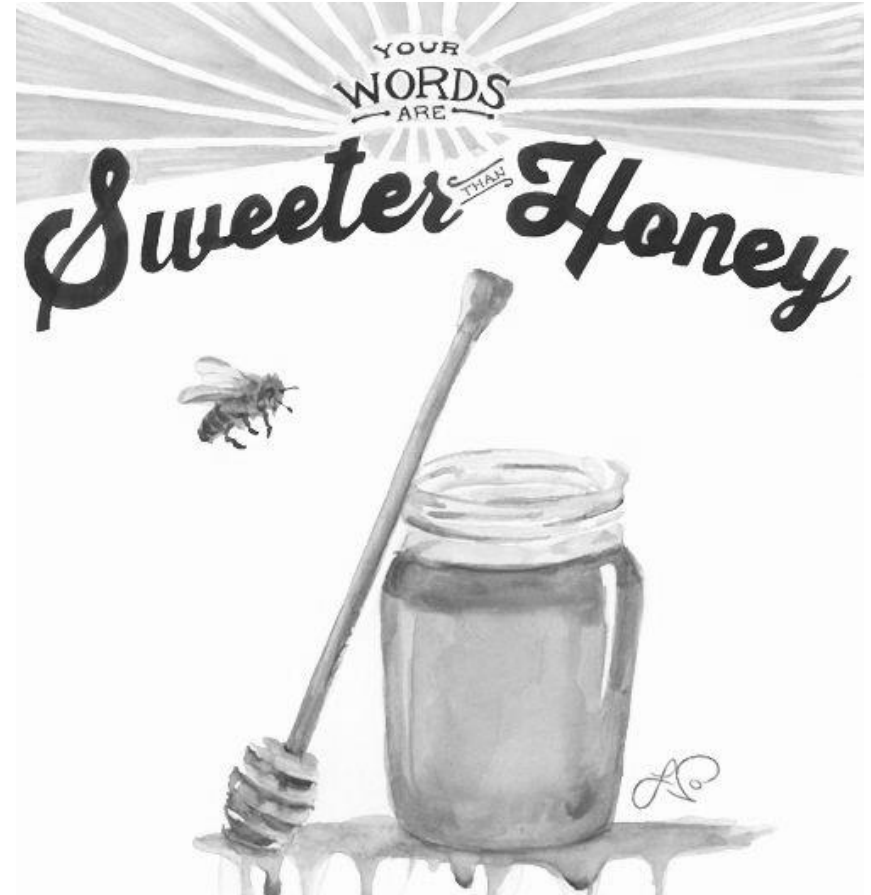

Missionary Emphasis:

ABC International Ministries: Ingrid Roldan-Roman/Panama

Ingrid works together with the staff at the Federation of Baptist Associations of Costa Rica. As a social extension of the Baptist Theological Center of the Panamanian Caribbean in the community of Chanquinola, Bocas del Toro, Panama, she directs a tutoring and feeding program for elementary and high school students who have fallen behind in their studies. The program is held at Ingrid's house, and many of the students come from a nearby slum that is without running water and electricity, and where the houses have mud floors and walls made from bamboo. She works with the students and their relatives in evangelism, social development, and pastoral care.

SBC Missionaries: Kristo Pango (Lead Church Planter, The Way of Hope Albanian Baptist Church, Madison, NY) ~ Their vision is to see a multiplying network of local churches among first-generation Albanian immigrants in North America as part of the mission to the global Albanian Diaspora and as an extension of the churches in Albanian and Kosova.

SBC CHAPLAINCY: Larry Brant (Southview Baptist Church, Jacksonville, NC) ~ Larry is a native of Cahokia, Illinois. He entered duty in the United States Navy in 2009, following more than 20 years as a civilian minister. Currently, he is assigned with the Marine Corps serving the Marines of the Combat Logistics Battalion 22, 2D Marine Logistics Group, Camp Lejeune, NC. He has had the honor of serving the men and women of the Navy, Coast Guard, and the Marines.
